Dear AUB Students,

We hope this message finds you and your loved ones well and safe.

We write to update you on several directions the university is taking to manage and support academic continuity in the current circumstances.

1. The University Senate has approved an extension of the withdrawal from classes deadline by two weeks, from April 9 to April 23, which becomes the last day students can withdraw from courses on AUBsis and receive a “W” grade for them.
2. With the goal to complete the spring term on time for all students, and especially those who are graduating this year and must move on with post-graduation opportunities, the university will be gradually resuming in-person exams and experiential learning activities, including labs, studios, and rotations, beginning Tuesday March 24. Please follow specific guidelines provided by your instructors for your courses. Classes will continue to be offered synchronously online.
3. Students who cannot sit for scheduled in-person exams will be offered makeup options by their course instructors. Information about final exams will be forthcoming later.
4. Students who cannot attend scheduled experiential learning activities (labs, studios, rotations, community engagement) on campus should discuss alternative options with their course instructors.
5. Students who cannot complete key parts of their course requirements within the timeframe of the spring term will be offered an “incomplete” option, the exact details of which are being determined and will be communicated soon.
6. Students who travel outside Lebanon must complete the “Petition for Travel Notification” to be able to continue their coursework while abroad.
